Funding

The competition was fierce for the State American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Grant and unfortunately, PWSD #5 did not receive the funding requested. The County ARPA funds were contingent upon us receiving the State funds. Contact has been made with the Presiding and District Commissioners to inquire if there is a possibility of securing the funds that were set aside (nearly \$1 million dollars) for our project. With the end of the year activities at the Court House and the Presiding Commissioner change, a meeting has not yet been secured.

There is an upcoming training in mid-January that the Missouri Rural Water Association (MRWA) is sponsoring regarding Funding for Water & Wastewater Projects and Board Member, Gail White, plans to take part. Rest assured PWSD #5 is being the best steward possible of our funds and we are seeking all avenues to secure grants and low-interest loans in order to continue with the project.

The anticipated project includes a new well, storage capacity, and security fencing. PWSD #5 previously purchased property for this project to serve Cedar Heights and Clearwater Condos along with the homes on Mission Hills Lane.

Collection Steps

Please be aware the following steps will occur before your water is locked out.

1. Phone call, message left if no answer. This will be the only phone contact.
2. Delinquency letter listing date of shut off if arrangements are not made.
3. Red shut off notice on door and another mailed within 10 days of termination water.
4. Termination.

Turning your water back on requires the following:

1. Water disconnected \$100 plus cost of disconnection locks and labor. Reconnect charge \$100 and \$500 deposit refundable at closing of account.
2. Payment of all back charges.

We hope that with these procedures in place owners will realize the importance of keeping their water/sewer bill current.
