

PWSD#5 Public Water Supply District #5

3rd Quarter Newsletter 2022



IMPORTANT WATER DISTRICT INFORMTION: The district has received two funding awards and is seeking a third. The funding will address the construction of a new well, 300,000 storage capacity, and security fencing. The property for this project is owned by the district and is located at the corner of Ozark Isle and Clearwater Drive.

#1 – A Drinking Water Engineering Report Grant from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (DNR) was secured earlier this spring. Darren Kreibel Consultants, LLC, was selected to perform the duties set forth. Of the \$30,000 awarded, DNR will cover \$24,000 while the district will be required to cover \$6,000 (80%/20%).

#2 – A Letter of Commitment was recently received from the Office of the Camden County Commission. They are earmarking \$939,802.50 of ARPA (American Recover Plan Act) funds towards the project. This is 21% of the overall cost of the project. PWSD #5 is setting aside \$50,000 of funds as well.

#3 – By mid-July, an application will be submitted to Missouri DNR for a Drinking Water ARPA Grant. The district is requesting \$3,485,448 to complete the project. Grant awards should be announced by mid-October.

A big Thanks to Board Member Gail White who has spent endless hours with all of the government red tape getting the PWSD#5 this far.

Delinquency – I would like to tell you in one of these newsletters that delinquency is non-existent however that is not the case.

The board has reexamined the collections policies and, in the future, they will be handled as followed.

1 qtr late a warning and finance charge

2nd qtr late a final warning and finance charge

At this time, you are 6 months late. If payment is not received PWSD#5 will begin the steps to disconnect your water.

A red notice will be placed on your door and mailed to you stating a date when your water will be locked out.

To remove the water, lock out, you will be required to pay a \$500 deposit, pay up all back charges, lien releases, attorney fees, processing and handling fees.
